

To Use Nursing Journals Online:

Instructions:

- From the SMCC home page, www.smcc.edu, look for “Departments” at the top of the page. When you point your cursor to “Departments” a drop down menu will appear and “Library” will be one of the choices. Click on “Library.” This will open the Library’s home page.
- On the Library’s home page, underneath the General Information box, you will see a red link to Nursing Journals Online.
- Click on Nursing Journals Online in red.
- When you get to the point where you need to put in a username and password, please enter the information published in the Library’s brochure. These were given to all nursing students during their Library orientation. If you need a new copy you may pick one up in the Library, at the circulation desk.

You should now be in ProQuest Nursing & Allied Health Source. This database includes journals, magazines, dissertations. You can find complete, full-text information from leading nursing, allied health, and related publications. ProQuest Nursing databases were designed to meet the needs of researchers at health-care facilities as well as students enrolled in nursing and allied health programs at academic institutions. This source provides abstracting and indexing for more than 690 titles, with over 570 titles in full-text.
