Students who have completed a high school CTE program are eligible for CTE scholarships if they meet the following criteria:

- Completed two years of a career-technical program at their high school (letter from counselor required)
- Enroll at SMCC in a CTE program full-time (at least 12 credit hours), within one year of graduating from high school
- Overall high school GPA of 3.5 (for full tuition scholarship) or 3.0 (for half tuition scholarship)
- Complete SMCC's admissions process and send final high school and/or college transcripts after graduating high school

- 2) **A letter from your high school counselor certifying that you have completed a two-year CTE program. The letter must be signed and on school letterhead.**
