Position: Night Head Resident-New Women's Residence Hall

Job Description: Southwest Mississippi Community College has an opening for a Night Head Resident in the New Women's Residence Hall. The head residents are student advocates who reside within and administer the residence halls. Head Residents administer the units: Check-in and Check-out, maintenance and housekeeping reporting, enforcing regulations and facilitating activities. Head residents will comply with all policies, procedures, and conditions printed in the current edition of the Southwest Mississippi Community College Student Handbook, the Housing Reservation Application, the College Catalog, the Employee Handbook, the Acknowledgement of Confidentiality in Working with Students Agreement and the written and verbal expectations provided by the Director of Student Activities and Housing and the Vice-President for Student Affairs. The Head Resident reports directly to the Director of Student Activities and Housing.

Duties and Responsibilities: Include but are not limited to:

- Will reside on campus in the residence hall apartment.
- Will always be available/in contact with the Director of Student Activities and Housing either by phone, in the resident hall, email, or cell phone. The head resident maintains a good working relationship with housekeeping, campus police, housing, and the office of the Vice-President for Student Affairs.
- Responsible for the upkeep of the building by cleaning common areas on a daily basis and the resident rooms when vacated.
- Communicates with all residents to establish friendly relations.
- Will make their presence known and be in residence hall, during night time hours and should be available during weekends. The employee should remain in the residence hall and respond as directed during times of crisis e.g. hurricanes, tropical storms etc.
- Conducts inspections each week to make sure rooms are clean
- Responsible for submitting maintenance/housekeeping request forms
- During the summer, duties will include cleaning, painting and other requirements to maintain the building, along with working with camps housed on our campus.

Qualifications & Experience:
